# SURVEY DISTRIBUTION

- Survey questions developed by VP Kalfsbeek-Goetz were sent to two groups of students

## 1. Currently-Enrolled Students

1. Sent via text to 6,646 students on Aug 13, 2021
2. 1,006 students completed the survey
3. 15.1% response rate

## 2. Previously-Enrolled Students

1. Sent via text to 10,586 previously-enrolled students on Aug 16, 2021
2. 255 completed the survey
3. 2.4% response rate





Previously-Enrolled Students





White Students



# SUMMARY

- Student preferences have shifted towards online courses
- Preferences for online services vary by service and student ethnicity
- Students who previously took a class at VC, but did not enroll in fall appeared to be more heavily impacted by Covid than currently-enrolled students
- Hispanic/Latinx students appeared to be more heavily impacted by Covid than White students

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### What is IE?

The Office of Institutional Effectiveness (IE) provides high-quality data and analysis to inform college decisions. Our office is located in the Day Road Center. If you ever feel like taking a leisurely walk across campus, stop by and say hello.

### Student Survey Results

We surveyed students in mid-August to understand how they have been impacted by Covid. We also asked about their preferences for courses and services. Before the pandemic, 60% of students preferred to take only in-person classes. When asked what type of class they think they will prefer after the pandemic is over, 40% said they would take in-person classes only, and 37% said that they would prefer a mix of online and in-person classes. The results also suggest that students who took a class in a prior term but didn't re-enroll in fall were more heavily impacted by Covid than students who are currently enrolled.

### Online Success Rates

Success (i.e. pass) rates in online classes have increased over the past few terms. Success rates in in-person classes have also increased, but by a much larger margin. This is likely due to the small number of in-person classes we offered, as well as the specific mix of classes. [Click here to view data for your favorite discipline or course.](#)
