Dear Raquel De Los Santos,

Thank you for all the work you put into completing your comprehensive program review. It has been reviewed by the College Planning Committee and the Executive Team. The College Planning Committee feedback is attached. Below, you will find comments, commendations, and recommendations from the Executive Team. These are provided for incorporation into your annual program planning processes. Typically, recommendations require planning improvements that will be implemented over time. Thus, in your subsequent annual mini-reviews, you will want to provide updates on progress made towards addressing these recommendations.

#### **Comments:**

- The program identified their strengths as the ability to connect students and alumni with regional employers, as well as increasing student accessibility to services. The Career Center has made strides in meeting "students where they are" by promoting services through various venues – in the quads, in the classrooms, and at events.
- The program identified their main weakness as lack of adequate staffing. Turnover in staffing and time factor in hiring resulted in the delay of launching an internship program and impacted the center's ability to host workshops and other career-prep opportunities.
- Despite the changes in staffing and delayed starts, the 968 student contacts for 2021-22 were significantly higher than 2019-20 (198%) and 2020-21 (2296%), as well as a respectable 87% of 2018-19 figures.

#### **Commendations:**

- 1. The program is commended for using data to understand our student demographics, which population of students are utilizing services, which populations are not and creating opportunities to serve them.
- 2. The program has revised its methods of outreach, including website, workshops, handouts, and presentations, allowing them to reach and support a larger number of students.
- 3. The program has a strong employer engagement commitment as evidenced by the increased employer internships and job postings, as well as the very successful Career Fair & Job Expo.

### Recommendations

1. Continue to build collaborative relationships with areas across campus and host additional events.

- 2. Explore opportunities to work with faculty to embed career-readiness competencies in an effort to help students be more competitive upon entry into the job market.
- 3. Continue industry outreach to increase internship opportunities for students.
- 4. Support efforts to hire and develop consistent staffing in the area.

CPC's overall recommendation is no action needed and to continue the program. While I agree that you are moving in the right direction, there are still opportunities to continue to grow and strengthen the program. Thank you again for your dedicated work in improving outcomes for our students.


