WELCOME

Welcome to our first concert of the season! Tonight, the Chamber Orchestra performs select movements from the great Czech composer Leoš Janáček's *Idyll.* Janáček (1854–1928) was inspired by Moravian Folk Music and frequently changes keys in his music to compliment the character of the melody by changing its timbre.

Bach's *Brandenburg Concerto No. 3* is the shortest of the six Brandenburg Concerti and possibly the best known. While the second movement has only two chords, we have decided to add two cadenzas for the violins (played brilliantly by Alex Fager and Carlos Ozuna, respectively), as would have been typical in the Baroque period.

The Symphony Orchestra presents Schumann's 3rd Symphony, which was inspired by a trip he took with his wife to Germany's Rhineland. Unlike the standard classical symphony form, this monumental work has five movements.

Join us in about a month for our next concert, to hear Barber's *Adagio for Strings*, "Mars" and "Jupiter" by Holst, string music by Grieg, and Anuj Bhutani's *After the Freeze* for String Orchestra and Hindustani soloists.
