- **Meeting Purpose:** Changes to Building Inspection AS Degree, and Construction Management AS Degree
- 1. **Old Business:**
 - 1.1 No old business, last meeting on record from August 17, 2016
 2. **New Business:**
 - 2.1 Changes in Units for Building Inspector and Construction Management AS Degree:
 - a) **Presentation:** Reviewed existing and proposed General Education and CT Elective units. GE units for VCCCD have been reduced from 29 to 24 units, and CT electives increased from 18 to 26 units so that with the new GE pattern, the degree total is 60 units.
 - b) **Discussion:** How to incorporate math classes into the program that will not discourage students from completing the program. It was decided that no additional electives for math is required for both of the CT programs beyond the general education math requirements.
 - c) **Discussion:** Suggestion to add V67 Building Accessibility Regulations as an elective for the Construction Management AS Degree.
 - d) **Discussion:** Suggestion to add Permit Tech course to the list of electives in the future.
 - e) **Discussion:** Suggestion to offer the International Building Code course in the fall every year, rather than in fall, even years only.
 - f) **Decisions:** Approved, with changes to add the proposed electives:
 1. Add CT V67, Building Accessibility Regulations, to the current list of electives for the Construction Management AS Degree.
 2. Add DRFT V04 (MT V04), Measurements and Computations, to the current list of CT electives for the Construction Management and Building Inspection AS degrees.
 3. No additional electives for math are required for both of the CT programs beyond the new VC general education math requirements.
 4. The AS degrees for CT to be changed from 6 total electives to 8 total electives for both the Construction Management and Building Inspection AS degrees.
